Lifestar responded to 74 911 calls this month that were paged out via Columbia County Dispatch. Lifestar also provided paramedic intercept services for Cambria EMS twice.

Lifestar met the response guidelines for all calls for the month of March. On 3/14 Lifestar was tasked with evacuating the Larson House due to flooding. 14 residents were needed to be evacuated and assistance was requested from Beaver Dam EMS, Rio EMS, and Waterloo EMS. Lifestar was able to provide four ambulances plus a fifth one that was dedicated other calls that may have come in during that time.
